THE STUDENT LIFE EXPERIENCE

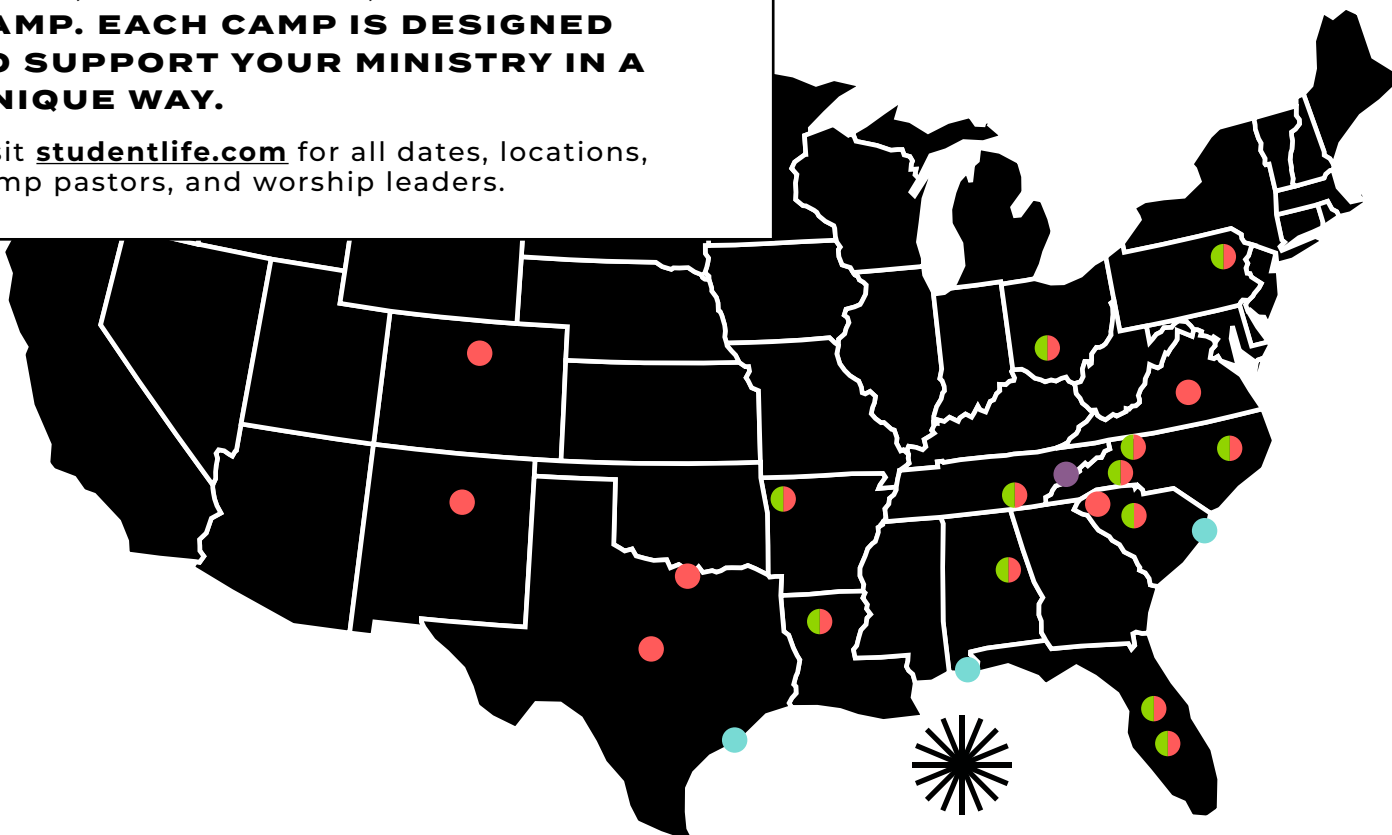

REC CAMP

Rec games are facilitated by Student Life staff with no special skills or athleticism required for students to participate. 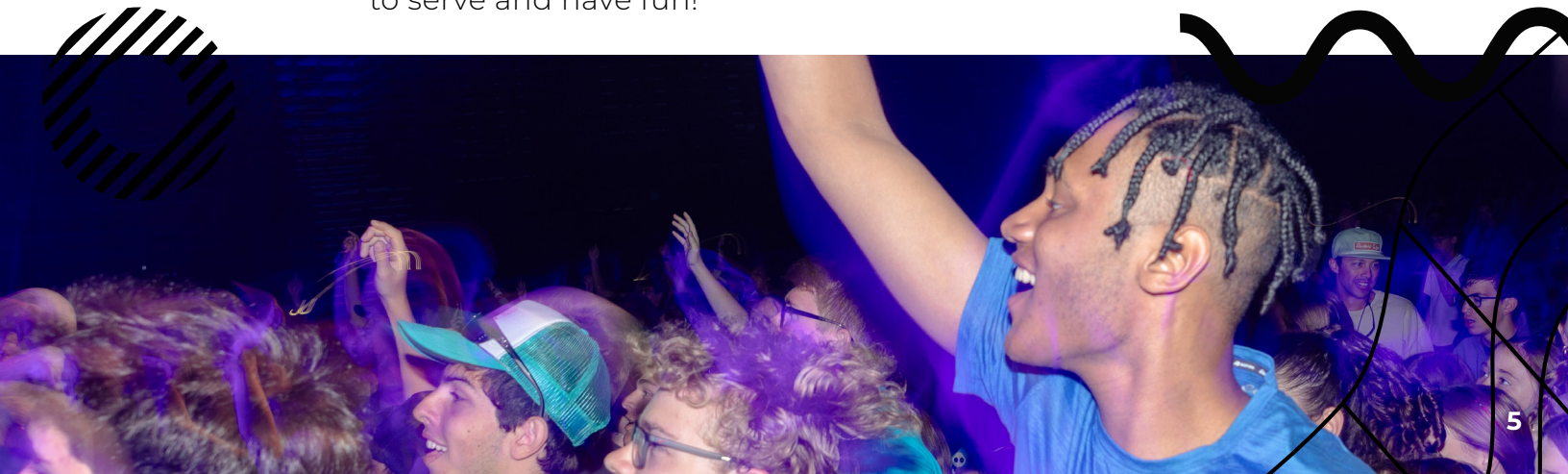
FLEX CAMP

MISSION CAMP

What makes Student Life Mission Camp different? SERVING. Mission groups have a unique opportunity to connect all the fun of camp with meeting real needs in local communities. You'll still experience Student Life Camp's engaging worship, Life Group discipleship time, and biblical teaching while spending a portion of your day connecting and serving with our ministry partners. We'll handle the logistics of your mission project. Just come ready to serve and have fun!





WHICH CAMP TYPE IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

REC

Students rotate through group bonding games within their Life Groups, paving the way for relationship building and discipleship opportunities that foster meaningful Life Group Bible Study and church group time.

BEACH

Groups have freedom to soak up the beach, sun, and surf and participate in local area attractions. At Beach Camp, you get to choose the lodging and meal options that fit your group's needs.

FLEX

Groups spend time outside of worship services participating in local area attractions including aquariums, outdoor adventure parks, arcades, miniature golf, museums, white water rafting, and more.

MISSION

Groups get outside their comfort zones by pouring into the local community by connecting and serving with our ministry partners.

PAYMENT TIMELINE

JANUARY 31:

A \$75-per-person non-refundable deposit is required to be paid on or before January 31. Any new or additional reservations made after this date will require an immediate \$75 non-refundable deposit per person. All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable after this date.

MAY 1:

An additional \$75 late cancellation fee will be incurred for each decreased person after May 1. When you decrease your registration, previous deposit payments made cannot be applied or transferred toward your final balance due.

14 DAYS BEFORE CAMP:

Your final balance is due no later than 14 days before your camp begins (35 days for FLEX). We will use your final registration number to make commitments to the camp locations and to calculate your final balance. All final balance money is non-refundable and non-transferable after 14 days before camp (35 days for FLEX).



FAQS



DO WE NEED TO BE A SPECIFIC DENOMINATION TO ATTEND YOUR EVENTS?

Student Life is a multi-denominational, evangelical ministry serving the local church and we invite like-minded, gospel-centered churches to join us at camp. We suggest that all churches review [Our Beliefs](#) so they can best determine if Student Life is a good fit for their group.

WHY DO YOU DO STUDENT LIFE CAMPS THE WAY YOU DO?

We designed Student Life events to support the men and women who lead students every week. Camp is just one week of the spiritual journey. We strive to partner with the local church by strengthening the relationships built there.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF STUDENT LIFE CAMPS?

We have numerous goals for our events, but ultimately, our goals involve life change happening in students, adults, and in us. In Scripture, every time someone spent time with Jesus, he or she went away changed. We hope each person leaves this experience changed. Not because of technical effects, engaging content, or even meeting new people, but because we have been with Jesus.

WHAT IS A LIFE GROUP?

A Life Group is about 8–12 students coming together under the leadership of adult leaders from your church. A Life Group's purpose is to learn about Jesus through Bible study, prayer, and group-bonding activities so they can continue to disciple and invest in your students' spiritual growth back home.

WHY DON'T YOU HIRE STAFF TO TEACH THE BIBLE STUDIES?

We believe it's important for adults from the local church to be involved in what happens at camp. After all, they go home with the students.

WHAT IS THE ADULT-TO-STUDENT RATIO?

We request one adult for every seven students at Rec and Mission Camps and one adult for every five students at Beach and Flex Camps.



WHAT WILL ADULT LEADERS DO AT CAMP?

Your adult leaders will be the all-stars of camp. They will disciple your students during Life Group, cheer them on during Rec, guide students at your mission site, spend time with students during free time, help enforce lights out so you're all ready to go for the next day, and more!

WHAT WILL STUDENT PASTORS DO AT CAMP?

Student Life Camps are designed to free student pastors from a lot of responsibility so that they can spend time building relationships with their students. We believe that student pastors having flexibility while at camp is an extremely important aspect of Student Life Camp.

CAN HALF OF MY GROUP DO MISSION CAMP AND THE OTHER HALF DO REC CAMP?

Of course! You are free to separate your middle and high school students this way, or you can allow students to choose the experience that most excites them. We will work with you to meet your group's needs. Each group will need their own adult leaders with them, and your groups would be listed under two separate registrations.

DO I NEED TO HAVE MY OWN TRANSPORTATION DURING THE WEEK?

Not at Rec Camp. Mission Camp requires groups to have transportation to and from their sites. Beach Camp and Flex Camp transportation needs will vary depending on the lodging you choose.

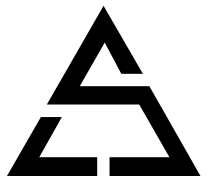
