We will learn how they have partnered with Panamanian indigenous followers of Christ to establish an outpost for mission work in the coastal town of Jaque, Panama. We will follow their river travels and learn how they share the gospel with the Emberá through bible storying. We will meet some Emberá whose lives have been transformed by God.
