#### **DAY 1: OUR CREATOR**

#### Main Point // God is our wonderful creator

From the beginning, God established Himself as our Creator. Chapter 1, verse 1 of the Scripture says, "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." God created the heavens and the earth. He created you and I. God made us as His beloved creation with a purpose on this earth.

Main Passage // Genesis 1

#### **DAY 2: OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS**

## Main Point // God is our righteousness

After God created humankind we chose to reject God and chose our own way of life. Our actions changed the course of human history. Apart from God we are enslaved to our own sin, but there is good news for the sinner!

Through the sacrifice of Jesus, God gives His righteousness to us. That righteousness allows us to be in relationship with God again.

Main Passage // Romans 3: 9-31

#### **DAY 3: OUR SHEPHERD**

## Main Point // Jesus is our Shepherd.

Jesus, the Son of the Living God, is our Shepherd. We are all lost sheep in need of a Shepherd to rescue us. God sent His Son to pay for our sins, so that we could be reconciled to God. Jesus is the fulfillment of all the Bible says about our Good Shepherd.

Main Passage // John 10:1-18

#### **DAY 4: OUR COMFORTER**

### Main Point // The Holy Spirit is our Comforter

As we wait for the full revival and restoration of our world, we can speak the good news of Jesus and the ultimate revival it brings to those around us. Revival is not just a moment in time or a show stopping worship service; but rather, it is a movement of God. Revival is enacted by consistent prayer of believers in the hope that those around them would come to know the everlasting and all encompassing love of God.

Main Passage // John 14: 18-26
